So instead, we invite you to **enter photographs** of up to eight of your *original* pictures, framed, unframed or on a canvas block. Whilst wholly voluntary it is suggested that exhibitors make a donation of 20% of the selling price for any work sold.

The method of entry is explained in the terms and conditions below and on the entry form supplied to you via your art group leader or by email. ### THE AUTUMN ART EXHIBITION 2020 - TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY

1) All work submitted must be the artist's original creations and available for sale. No reproductions, only original work is allowed. You may enter up to 8 paintings or drawings, framed, unframed or on canvas blocks at **£5 per picture**. Minimum sale price £40. Whilst wholly voluntary it is suggested that exhibitors make a donation of 20% of the selling price for any work sold.

**Note** – 100% of all virtual hanging fees goes to the Friends' fund raising

- 2) **Recommended painting or canvas block maximum size, 20" x 30"**.
- 3) **Method of Entry** – paintings must be photographed up close, in natural light against a blank, light neutral background. Make the painting fill the frame. Turn the camera/phone from landscape to portrait to suit the artwork. If using a digital camera use the high-resolution setting. Most smart phones take photographs at reasonably high resolution. Once you are satisfied with the photograph(s) you can complete the entry form. **PLEASE NOTE** that each painting you submit must be attached to a separate email (one only per email) and on each email the price, artist's details and painting description/name referring to the attached art work **MUST** be laid out in the manner requested on the entry form or your entry may be rejected. You must also attach a PDF or scanned copy of the entry form on the first email you send. The entry form must be signed by you, where indicated, to qualify for entry. Payment for the 'hanging' fees may be made over the phone by card or cheques sent to the Friends office. Thank you. Entries must be sent to: **esh-tr.friendsdgh@nhs.net**
- 4) **Method of Sale** – viewers of the virtual exhibition who wish to purchase an artwork will do so by emailing **esh-tr.friendsdgh@nhs.net** quoting the painting number. This will be on a first come first served basis and payment will be collected by the Friends office. The painting/portfolio will then be updated on the website as 'under offer'.
- 5) **Payment to artists for SOLD work**. The Friends of Eastbourne Hospital will collect the sale proceeds on your behalf and will pay over the money if applicable net of the suggested 20% donation from **30<sup>th</sup> November 2020**.
- 6) **Method of Collection of Artwork** – because this is an online exhibition, sales could possibly occur anywhere in the UK. Therefore, artists are recommended to take this into account when pricing. Once a painting is sold artists will be informed and by signing the entry form you are agreeing, under GDPR regulations that your telephone number may be given to the person who has paid for the painting. They will contact you and you will arrange collection between you. The artist will decide where and how the painting is to be handed over or to be posted/delivered to and determine packaging and postage costs. The only responsibility of the Friends is to pass the money, if applicable net of the suggested 20% donation, from 30<sup>th</sup> November 2020 to the artist. This will only occur after the date above and when the artist confirms to the Friends office by email that the customer has the painting and is satisfied with the sale.
- 7) **Early entry is encouraged**. The **closing date for entries** is now **Friday 16<sup>th</sup> October 2020**.
- 8) **The Exhibition Organisers reserve the right to reject any entry upon whatever grounds they deem appropriate. Their decision is final**. Thank you for your co-operation.
