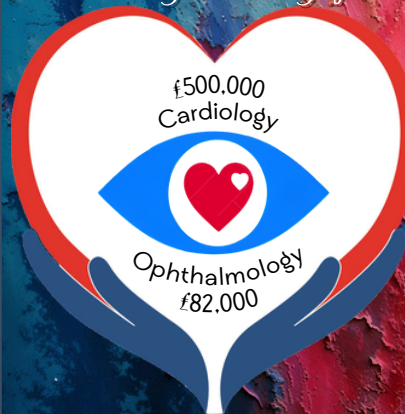

Friends of Eastbourne Hospital are delighted to be holding their 21st Annual Art Exhibition for local artists to display and sell their original framed pictures.

Ann Caffyn – Art Exhibition Organiser: - We are very grateful to the Headmaster for allowing us the free use of St Andrew's Prep School Gym to stage the event for the 21st consecutive year. It is a very spacious venue in which up to 230 paintings can be displayed. We invite all exhibitors and their guests to join us for a complimentary glass of wine at the preview evening on Friday 23rd October.

Dr. Harry Walmsley – Chairman, Friends of Eastbourne Hospital:- The money that the Friends of Eastbourne Hospital raise at this year's Art Exhibition will go towards our general funds and the 2026 Major Projects. The aim is to raise £582K for two departments. The first is to upgrade the Ophthalmic microscope in the eye theatre to maintain Eastbourne as one of two centres for eye surgery in East Sussex. The second project is to fund equipment for a third cardiac catheter room in the state of the art cardiology department, one of the top in the country. Having two such specialties in Eastbourne is great news for our town.

Preview Evening – Friday 23rd October – 6.00 p.m. until 8.00 p.m. – The evening will include a raffle (draw on Sunday) for a painting donated by popular local artist Tracey Gross, and a bottle tombola. The winner will be contacted at the end of the Exhibition on Sunday.

The Chatfield Silver Cup will be awarded to the 'Best in Show' painting as judged by an experienced and professional local artist.

Saturday 24th October – Talk by Terry Henson, Art Historian, on Eric Ravilious at 2.00 p.m.

Sunday 25th October – Caricaturist Ian Parratt will be creating sketches of guests for a donation to the Friends at 2.00 p.m.

The winner of the 'Peoples' Choice' painting (voted for by exhibition visitors over the weekend until 3.00 p.m. Sunday) will be announced after the draw for the donated painting raffle. Slips for voting will be given out with the catalogue.

1. You may enter up to 4 framed paintings or canvas blocks at a hanging cost of £5 per entry. NB. Only one painting per each entry fee.
2. All entries must have a taut cord. Please NO WIRE for health and safety reasons.
3. Paintings must be labelled on the back giving Name, Address, Title, Medium and Price.
4. Portfolios: 4 for the price of 3 at £3 per entry. All portfolios must be labelled at top right front with Name, Title and Price. Please ensure portfolio entries are suitably backed and wrapped in acetate.
5. Early entry is encouraged. The closing date for entries is **Friday 18th September 2026**. There is hanging space for only 230 paintings so please return your exhibition entry form, with payment, as early as possible.
6. The Friends can accept no responsibility for any loss or damage to any painting or portfolio whilst at the exhibition.
7. The Exhibition Organisers reserve the right to reject any entry upon whatever grounds they deem appropriate.
8. Payment to Artists for SOLD work. Friends of Eastbourne Hospital will collect the sale proceeds on behalf of the artists and will pay over the money net of the 20% donation within 7 days of the close of the exhibition. Payment will be made via BACS using the bank account details from the cheque/bank transfer used for entry fees.
