THE AUTUMN ART EXHIBITION 2023 - TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY

By entering artists agree to abide by these terms and conditions

- 1. Please note all work submitted must be the artist's original creations and available for sale. No reproductions, only original work is allowed. You may enter up to 4 framed paintings or drawings, either framed or on canvas blocks at £5 per picture. Minimum sale price £40.Note 100% of all hanging fees goes to the Friends' fund raising. Exhibitors are requested to make a donation of 20% of the selling price of any work that is sold which they agree may be deducted before payment to them of the net proceeds.
- 2. No framed painting or canvas block to be larger than 22" x 32". (559mm x 813mm)
- 3. Framed paintings must have a taut cord (nylon) to facilitate hanging. NO WIRE for health & safety reasons and possible damage to other works. Cord should be secured by screw eyes, D rings or other metal fittings at 1/3rd distance from the top. These must be securely taped to cover any of those metal fixings to avoid damage to other paintings. Artwork must be secure within the frame.
- 4. Paintings must be labelled on back giving Name, Address, Title, Medium & Price.
- 5. *SPECIAL OFFER* 4 for the price of 3 You may submit up to 4 original portfolios (suitably backed and completely wrapped with acetate film, minimum sale price £20) at £2 per entry for up to 3 and a 4th free. Portfolios must have a stick-on label giving Name, Address, Title and Price on top right front of painting. Please note 100% of all portfolio fees goes to the Friends' fund raising.
- 6. <u>PLEASE NOTE</u> Times for receiving paintings (by surnames) on Thursday 26th October. Please remove any packaging before registration.

- 9. **Early entry is encouraged.** The closing date for entries is Friday 8th September 2023. There is hanging space for only 230 paintings so please return your exhibition entry form, with payment, as early as possible.
